

# Addition Tic-Tac-Toe

Players choose markers in two different colors. The first player chooses two addends from beneath the game board, places a paper clip on each, and marks the sum with his/her color marker. The second player moves one of the paper clips to a new addend, finds the sum, and marks the sum with his/her color marker. Play continues until one player has marked four sums in a row, a column, or a diagonal. Note: it is legal to move the paper clip to the same addend of the other paper clip to allow for doubles such as  $5 + 5$ .
