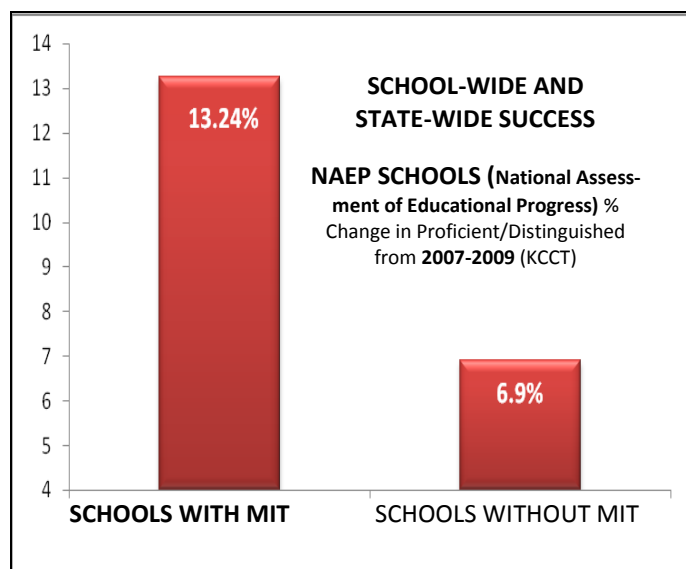
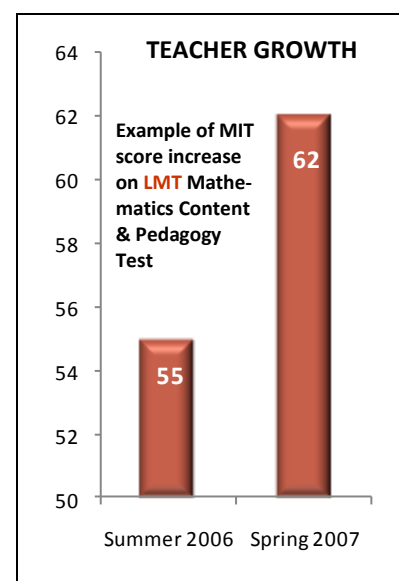
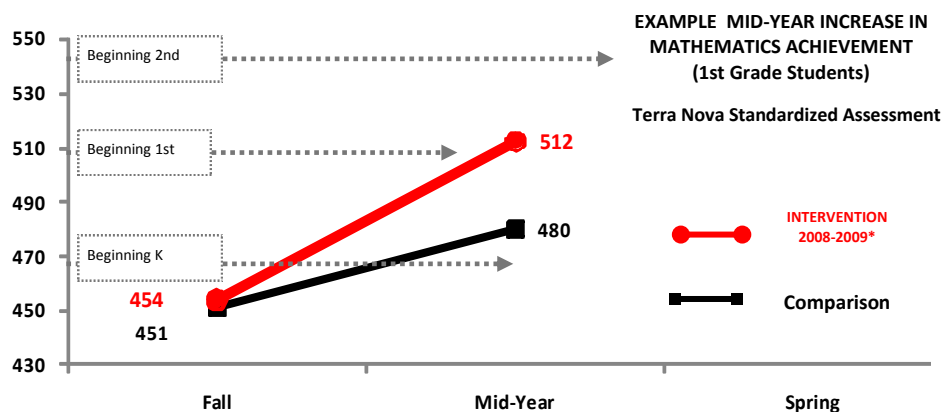
Just in time for the launch of the new Common Core mathematics standards requiring more in-depth, rigorous learning of number at the elementary grades,

Kentucky's force of highly-trained mathematics intervention teachers (MITs) are...

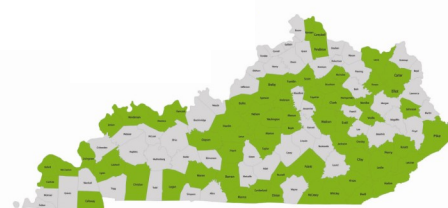
